BSP and SMEP Stand Together in Facing Threats of Oil Spill in the Region

Print Email <u>BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN</u>: In an effort to tackle oil <u>spill</u> incident in the Brunei Darussalam's waters, the Brunei Shell Petroleum (BSP) Company conducted a "Golden Shield Exercise" also known as the Tier 3 Oil Spill Response Exercise which is organised in cooperation with the Shell Malaysia Exploration and Production (SMEP).

The three-day training involved the mobility of the physical sources from both nations for the cleanup activity along the beach and also the <u>marine vessels</u>. A briefing on the training was held yesterday at the <u>Royal</u> Berkshire, Royal Brunei Polo and Riding Club in Jerudong.

In his speech, the Director of Marine, Awg Hj Matnor Hj Salleh, who is also the Chairman for the <u>National</u> Oil Spill Contingency Plan Management Committee of Brunei Darussalam, stressed that all agencies involved must cooperate with each other and take the opportunity to explore one's operation procedures level or the Standard Operation Procedures (SOP).

He added that they should also come up with relevant strategies and at the same time to interact as a team when tackling any large-scale incidents.

The Golden Shield Exercise is a joint effort between the National Oil Spill Contingency Plan


