THE Meteorological Observation Station Brunei International Airport has recorded above average rainfall for the month of January, said a statement released by the Brunei Darussalam Meteorological Department yesterday.

The statement said the observation station registered 377.8 mm of rainfall from early January to January 24, surpassing the long-term average for January of 309.5 mm. The long-term average was recorded from 1966 to 2014.

The Meteorological Department would like to advise the general public, motorists, and mariners to take necessary steps and precautions, especially during the active weather conditions to ensure safety and the prevention of undesirable incidents.

It said the department would monitor weather conditions closely and would issue an appropriate weather advisory or warnings, whenever necessary.

Members of the public can also contact the Duty Meteorological Forecaster at the Forecast Office, Weather Services Division at the Brunei International Airport through the Weather Line 114 or 2345567 for the latest weather update.
